Tomasz Launches 50/50/50 Expedition at San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge on Mother's Day, Honoring His Mother

San Francisco, CA — May 10, 2026 — Today, Tomasz began the first day of his **50/50/50 Expedition** at the iconic **Golden Gate Bridge** in San Francisco, launching a meaningful journey dedicated to his mother on **American Mother's Day**. Tomasz, who describes himself as the "**Polish Forrest Gump**," is setting out on a remarkable endurance journey filled with purpose, symbolism, and personal tribute.

The opening day carried special significance as Tomasz began his route from one of the West Coast's most recognizable landmarks. The expedition blends endurance, reflection, and purpose, and his mother's influence is at the heart of the journey.

Tomasz is now on his way to Oregon. The driving distance from San Francisco to Portland is about **638 miles**, and it typically takes about **10 hours 51 minutes** to **10 hours 55 minutes** to drive under normal conditions; in a camper, planning for **12 to 15 hours** is more realistic because of slower travel, stops, and rest breaks.

Will he fall short of Portland and how will that impact the drive to Seattle, Washington?
