Tomasz, the “Polish Forrest Gump,” Presses On With Day 3 of the 50/50/50 Expedition in Seattle

Seattle, WA — May 11, 2026 — Tomasz, the self-proclaimed “**Polish Forrest Gump,**” continues **Day 3** of his **50/50/50 Expedition** in Seattle with a **26-mile run** beginning at **Seattle City Hall** as part of a pop-up marathon effort. The day reflects both the endurance and the unpredictability of the journey, as Tomasz pushes forward through a tightly managed travel schedule and changing logistics.

Because of the schedule shift, Tomasz is now facing a required **7+ hour drive in the camper after completing his 26-mile run** as he continues the journey north. Following the Seattle stop, he will need to move quickly, since he is scheduled to be on a plane to Alaska later the same day, with departure set for **4:15 p.m..**

The expedition continues to build momentum as a story of grit, movement, and purpose. Like a modern-day travel adventure, Tomasz’s route combines physical challenge with constant motion, making each day feel like a new chapter in a larger journey.
